General Information

You must be a member of Watertown Boys & Girls Club to participate in all summer programs. A summer membership can be obtained for \$10.00 (valid 6/21/17 through 8/31/17).

For the first full week of summer, we will be hosting **Club Week!** This camp session will be held at Watertown Boys & Girls Club. Activities include arts & crafts, outdoor games, sports, swimming and much more!

Summer Adventure is a camp program for members ages 7-12. The program offers youth a safe environment to build skills, foster new friendships, learn self-reliance, and become more confident all while having fun and being active in the great outdoors!

Summer Adventure will take place at **Hale Reservation (80 Carby Street, Westwood, MA)**. Camp Hale offers acres of wooded land perfect for exploring the natural world. Campers will participate in daily swim lessons, arts & crafts, nature walks, archery, lake swimming, fishing, hiking, and daily specials. A full-time nurse is on duty at all times with emergency facilities accessible within the town of Westwood.

The last week of summer, we will offer **Trip Week!** This four-day week brings campers on a different field trip each day. Past trips have included Kimball Farm, Canobie Lake Park, Fun World, Chunky's, and State Parks. A list of this year's trips will be posted on our website when available.



Registration

- Registrations will be accepted in person beginning March 1, 2017.
- A **\$50** non-refundable deposit is required to hold your child's place for each registered week.
- Registrations must be mailed in or submitted in person at the Club. Registration and health forms will be available at the Club as well as online. The required health forms must be completed and returned prior to your child's first day of camp.

This camp must comply with the regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, and be licensed by the Westwood Board of Health.

Drop Off and Pick Up

- Drop off is between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m. All campers must check in with a staff member each morning.
- **Children must be dropped off prior to 9:00 a.m.** when the camp bus leaves. If campers miss the bus, they need to be driven to Camp Hale by a parent/guardian.
- The camp bus returns to the Club at approximately 4:45 p.m.
- Pick-up is from 4:45 to 5:30 p.m. **Children must be picked up no later than 5:30 p.m.** Please note a fee may apply for any child picked up after 5:30 p.m.
- Campers must be signed out each day. We cannot leave a child unattended to wait to be picked up. To ensure your child's safety, **please be prepared to show ID at pick-up.** Campers and JCLs ages 12 and over are able to sign themselves out with prior written permission.
- Please note: in the event of heavy rain or inclement weather, camp will be held at Watertown Boys & Girls Club. Rainy day activities may include free swim, gym activities, games, or field trips (i.e. bowling, movies, etc.)



Lunch

All campers need to bring their own non-perishable lunch, snacks, and drinks to camp. **NO GLASS BOTTLES, PLEASE!** A refillable water bottle is recommended to help your camper stay hydrated. There are water fountains available on site.

Attention Teenagers

Are you looking for something to do this summer?

This leadership position is for ages 13 and up. Teens looking to **earn credit for Community Service hours** are able to use half of the hours worked at summer camp. Applications are available at the Club. All accepted applicants are assigned at least two weeks.

All JCLs must attend 2 weeks of our summer program to join Trip Week.
